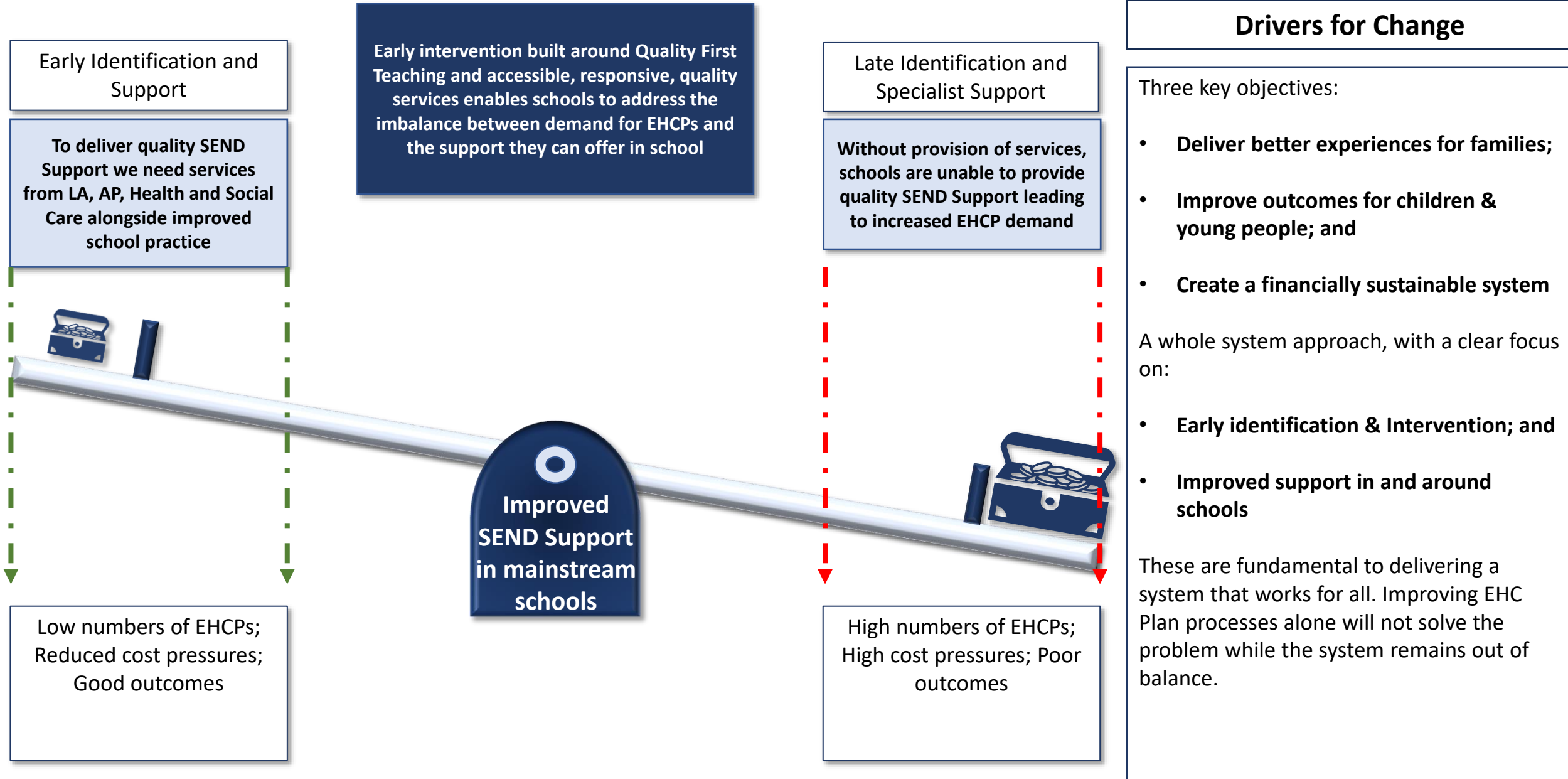

Sharing Practice across Region

The Change Programme is specifically designed to test and refine the system level reforms as a **package**, across local authorities with differing levels of performance and capability. The CP's purpose is to:

- **Ensure the reforms will deliver** the key three objectives;
- **Understand what it will take** to get the system to deliver nationally consistent standards; and
- Identify and address any **unintended consequences**.

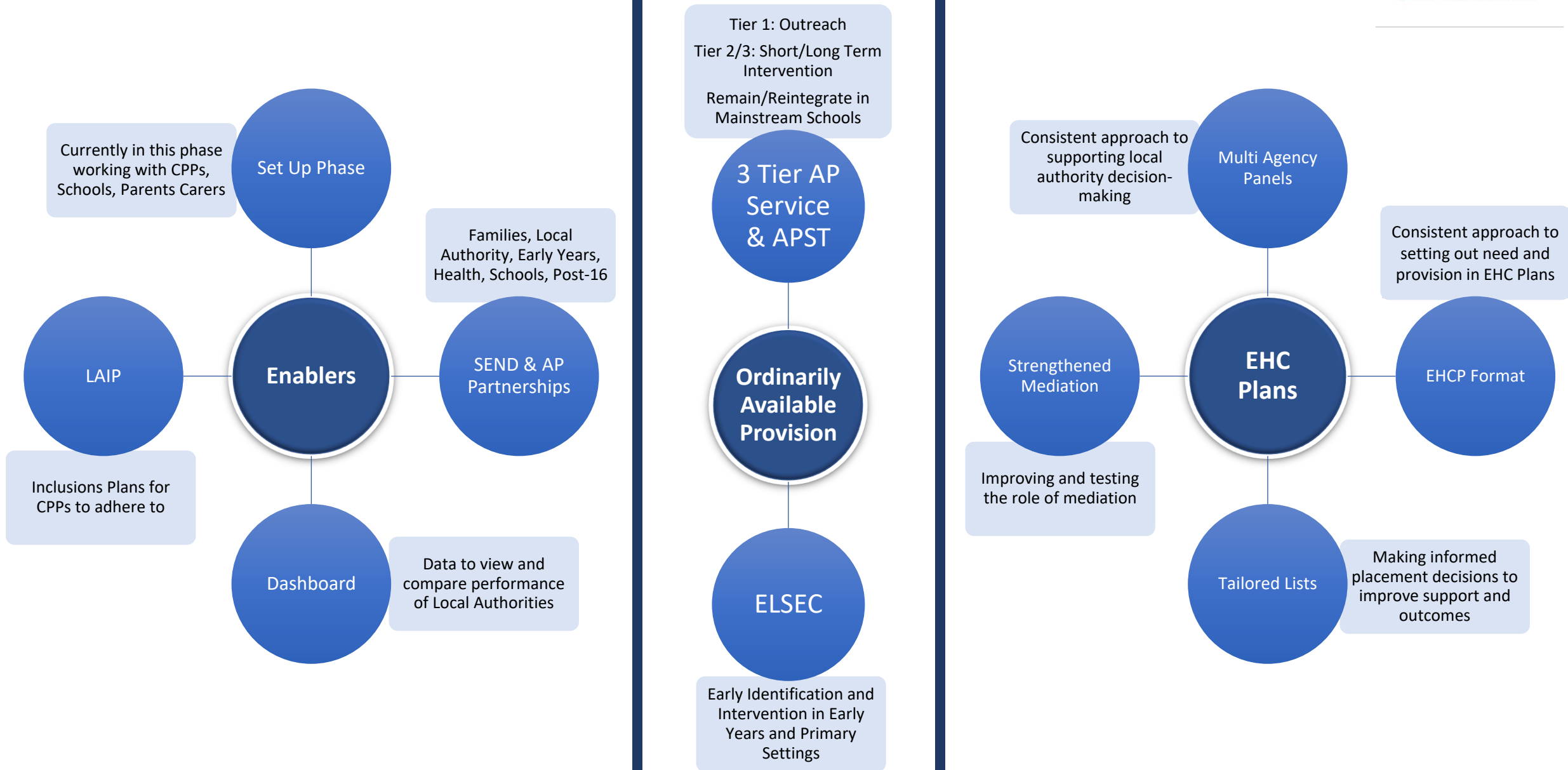
A geographical cluster of LAs has been identified in each of DfE's 9 regions. Working with key partners at a CPP-wide strategic level, **each CPP will test broadly the same proto-type SEND and AP system.**

Each CPP **will receive 'boots on the ground' support and expertise** from DfE and their external Delivery Partner.

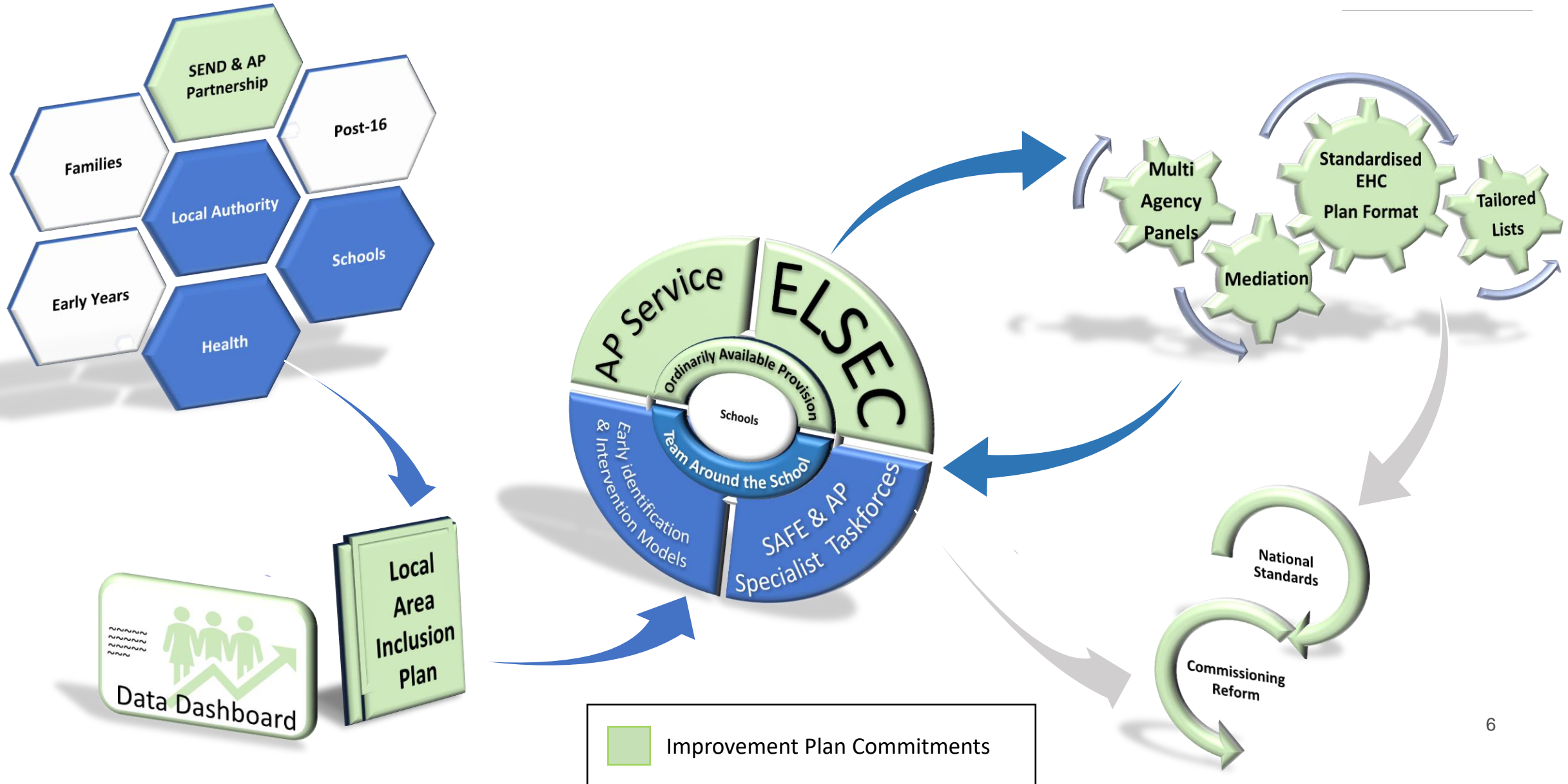
National Change Programme Partnership Map
